DIRECTIONS TO THE MARRIOTT HOTEL

Walking from Leeds Train Station:

Exit the station by **Marks & Spencer Food**, turn right and follow the footpath round and down the slope leading to Boar Lane. Turn right onto Boar Lane and walk along passing **Subway** and **Greggs** to the right. At **Toni & Guy's Hairdressers** turn right into Trevelyan Square, the Marriott is to the left.

Driving from M62 East

- From **M62** at Junction **29**, join the **M621** and exit the **M621** at Junction **3** following signs for **A653 Leeds Centre**
- Continue through the lights until the **Yorkshire Forward** building and **Bridgewater Apartments** are on your left then follow **the brown tourist signs** for the **Royal Armouries & West Yorkshire Playhouse**
- Right turn at the next traffic lights. As you turn right **ASDA Head Office** will be on the left hand side
- Move into the left hand lane and take the first left at the next set of traffic lights, sign posted "**Shoppers Car Park**" and "**Station**", stay in the left hand lane
- Follow the road round to the left, over a bridge and move into the right hand lane at the set of traffic lights with the **Cosmopolitan Hotel** on the left and "**Barracoa Luxe Bar**" on the right
- Go straight on at the lights into **Briggate**, under the railway bridge and up to the next set of traffic lights, moving into the left hand lane. **McDonalds** will be in front of you
- Turn into **Boar Lane** and take the first left between **Toni & Guy Hairdressers** and shop "**On The Wall**" and the **Leeds Marriot Hotel** is on your left

Driving from M62 West

- From the **M62** at Junction **27** join the **M621**. Exit the **M621** at Junction **3** following signs for **A653 Leeds Centre**
- Continue through the lights until the **Yorkshire Forward** building and **Bridgewater Apartments** are on your left then follow **the brown tourist signs** for the **Royal Armouries & West Yorkshire Playhouse**
- Right turn at the next traffic lights. As you turn right **ASDA Head Office** will be on the left hand side
- Move into the left hand lane and take the first left at the next set of traffic lights, sign posted "**Shoppers Car Park**" and "**Station**", stay in the left hand lane
- Follow the road round to the left, over a bridge and move into the right hand lane at the set of traffic lights with the **Cosmopolitan Hotel** on the left and "**Barracoa Luxe Bar**" on the right
- Go straight on at the lights into **Briggate**, under the railway bridge and up to the next set of traffic lights, moving into the left hand lane. **McDonalds** will be in front of you
- Turn into **Boar Lane** and take the first left between **Toni & Guy Hairdressers** and shop "**On The Wall**" and the **Leeds Marriot Hotel** is on your left

Driving from M1 North

- From the **M1** at Junction **43**, join the **M621**. Exit the **M621** at Junction **3** following signs for **A653 Leeds Centre**
- Continue through the lights until the **Yorkshire Forward** building and **Bridgewater Apartments** are on your left then follow **the brown tourist signs** for the **Royal Armouries & West Yorkshire Playhouse**
- Right turn at the next traffic lights. As you turn right **ASDA Head Office** will be on the left hand side
- Move into the left hand lane and take the first left at the next set of traffic lights, sign posted "**Shoppers Car Park**" and "**Station**", stay in the left hand lane
- Follow the road round to the left, over a bridge and move into the right hand lane at the set of traffic lights with the **Cosmopolitan Hotel** on the left and "**Barracoa Luxe Bar**" on the right
- Go straight on at the lights into **Briggate**, under the railway bridge and up to the next set of traffic lights, moving into the left hand lane. **McDonalds** will be in front of you

Driving from M1 South

- From the **M1** at Junction **42**, join the **M621**. Exit the **M621** at Junction **3** following signs for **A653 Leeds Centre**
- Continue through the lights until the **Yorkshire Forward** building and **Bridgewater Apartments** are on your left then follow **the brown tourist signs** for the **Royal Armouries & West Yorkshire Playhouse**
- Right turn at the next traffic lights. As you turn right **ASDA Head Office** will be on the left hand side
- Move into the left hand lane and take the first left at the next set of traffic lights, sign posted "**Shoppers Car Park**" and "**Station**", stay in the left hand lane
- Follow the road round to the left, over a bridge and move into the right hand lane at the set of traffic lights with the **Cosmopolitan Hotel** on the left and "**Barracoa Luxe Bar**" on the right
- Go straight on at the lights into **Briggate**, under the railway bridge and up to the next set of traffic lights, moving into the left hand lane. **McDonalds** will be in front of you
- Turn into **Boar Lane** and take the first left between **Toni & Guy Hairdressers** and shop "**On The Wall**" and the **Leeds Marriot Hotel** is on your left

All Other Approaches to Leeds (from A65, A660, A61, A58, A64, A63)

- On approaching Leeds follow signs for the City Centre and join the City Centre Loop. For A65 will be Junction 2 (J2) – **Metropole Hotel** on the right hand side, for A660 will be **J6 – Merrion Centre and Oceana Club** on the left hand side, for A61/A58 will be **J10**, for A64/A63 will be **J11 – West Yorkshire Playhouse** on the left hand side.
- Pick up brown tourist signs "city centre hotels" as you drive along the city loop
- As you pass through **Junction 15 (J15)** on the loop, (Parish Church on your left and silver ball shape fountain), get into the right hand lane and look out for the brown **Marriott Hotel** and **Park Plaza Hotel** tourist sign, which indicates that you need to turn right
- Exit the loop by turning right at the traffic lights at **Junction 16 (J16)** called **Bridge End** (look out for the **Cosmopolitan Hotel** opposite and "**Floridita**" restaurant on the left hand side). You are now in Briggate
- Go under the railway bridge and up to the next set of traffic lights, moving into the left hand lane. **McDonalds** will be in front of you
- Turn into **Boar Lane** and take the first left between **Toni & Guy Hairdressers** and shop "**On The Wall**" and the **Leeds Marriott Hotel** is on your left
