ABOUT THE COURSE

Three joint sessions are aimed at all urogenital radiologists, and one is split between urological and gynaecological topics. We have aimed to cover some interesting topics on subjects that are fundamental to the practice of radiology in this field, but don't always receive the attention they deserve.

The main meeting starts with a morning on imaging abnormalities of the urogenital tract. The underlying developmental and anatomic principles are essential knowledge for the specialist urogenital radiologist, and we predict a fascinating morning of talks.

The second session is split between urological and gynaecological Radiology. Several areas of recent controversy and recent developments in andrology are covered, as well as some old techniques verging on extinction. On the gynaecological side there are talks on adnexal masses, endometriosis and staging endometrial and cervical cancer.

Professor Mark Emberton and Dr Lindsay Machan will give a joint keynote lecture on "Uroradiology: Is It Doomed? Who is Going to Keep the Keys to the 3T MRI and the Fusion Biopsy Machine?" To be Followed by dinner at the excellent Quaglinos, Mayfair.

On the second day the session on nodal imaging will be of interest to all. Before lunch we will have a panel discussion of interesting cases, and finally in the afternoon we have a session headed by some eminent (and entertaining) surgeons on the interface between surgery and radiology, current controversies and future developments.

There will be a scientific session presenting research in the field of urological and gynaecological radiology. The format is posters and a three minute presentation, with prizes for the best.

This course is designed for all radiologists, nuclear medicine physicians and other specialists interested in the diagnosis and management of urogenital disorders.

The meeting will be held in London, UK, at the Royal Over-Seas League, a building with a grand façade and an interesting history, near Green Park underground station and the Ritz Hotel, within easy walking distance of the West End.

The course dinner will be held after the close of lectures on Thursday at Quaglinos, which is just a short walk from the venue.

The Practical Prostate day will start with 2 hours of lectures on the indications for prostate MRI, the benefits of different sequences, optimising protocols, reporting systems and 'check areas'.

The rest of the day will be spent reporting scans on dedicated OSIRIX workstations, with one machine per participant, discussion, and histological correlation for each case. This course follows on from two previously sold out (so book early!) Practical Prostate MRI courses in September 2012 and April 2013 which have received excellent feedback from participants.

Submission of abstracts (no more than 250 words) for scientific or educational posters are invited. For scientific posters the author will be required to give a three minute presentation on the first day of the conference in the morning poster session.
