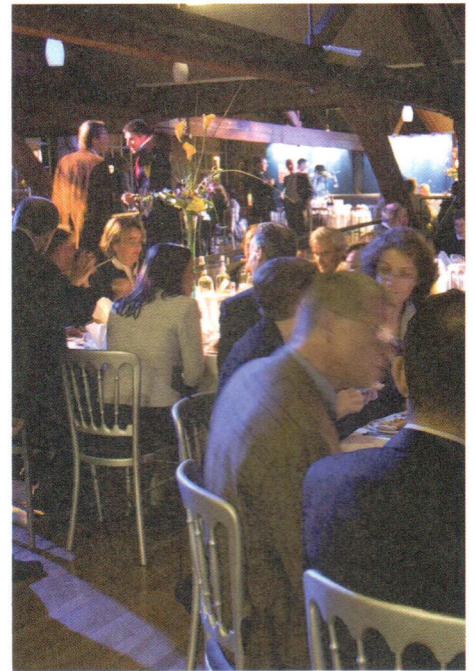
Welcome to Manchester!

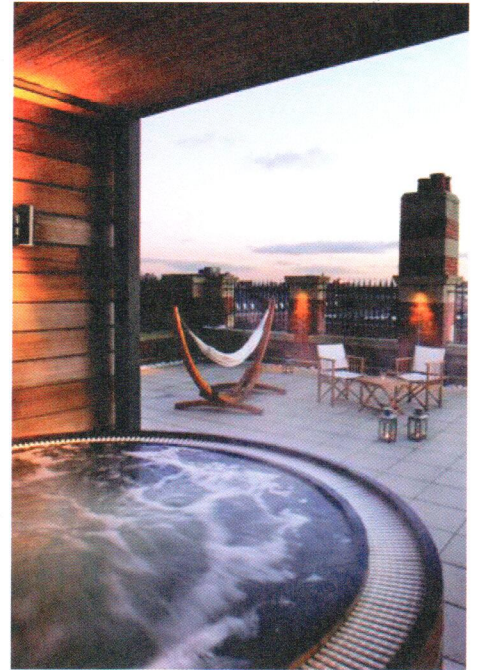
